Aos vinte e nove dias do mês de janeiro de dois mil e dezoito pelas catorze horas, teve lugar no CIIMAR a reunião do júri com vista à seriação das candidaturas recebidas para duas bolsas de investigação para Mestre no âmbito do projeto ERC Starting grant “FattyCyanos”, com a referência (Grant agreement no: 759840) na instituição CIIMAR (Interdisciplinary Centre of Marine and Environmental Research), através do European Programme Horizon 2020. O júri foi constituído pelo Doutor Pedro Leão, Doutora Rosário Martins e Doutor Ralph Urbatzka.

Foram ainda recebidas, fora do prazo, não tendo por isso sido consideradas pelo júri, as candidaturas de Abdullah Shaik, Manoj Kumar, Muhd Shahari e Silvia Magri.

O candidato Bernard Turkson foi excluído por não ter apresentado candidatura completa, nomeadamente por falta do documento indicado no edital, relativo a uma descrição das atividades passadas, interesses de investigação e motivação.

On the 29th of January, 2018, a jury meeting took place at CIIMAR to evaluate and classify the applications that were received for the contest for two positions of research grants for MSc degree holders, under the scope of the ERC Starting Grant “FattyCyanos”, with the reference “Grant Agreement no: 759840), funded through the European Programme Horizon 2020 and in which CIIMAR is the single beneficiary. The jury was formed by Dr. Pedro Leão, Dr. Rosário Martins and Dr. Ralph Urbatzka.

Twenty-three candidates, presented their applications, namely Ahsan Hameed, Beatriz Bento, Bernard Turkson, Caroline Autréau, Catarina Cabanas, Cátia Soares, David Dinis, Dora Pittrich, Grégoire Marin, Harsha Vardhan, Janardhan Ausuri, Kathleen Abt, Khaled Abdrabo, Mariana Delgado, Miguel Osset Álvarez, Mónica Fabra, Monica Nyansa, Nyemb Jean Noel, Paula Rodriguez, Sandra Carvalho, Suneel LANKA, Teresa Martins and Uira Oliveira. The applications of Abdullah Shaik, Manoj Kumar, Muhd Shahari and Silvia Magri were received outside the legal time-frame and were therefore not considered by the jury.

The candidate Bernard Turkson was excluded as his application was not complete, as it was missing the required document (as set forth by the position Announcement) relative to the candidate’s past activities, research interest and motivation.

The remaining candidates were evaluated by the jury, according to the criteria set forth in the Announcement for this position. This resulted in the following classifications (0 to 10 values) and ranking:
