

SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY MANAGEMENT GRANT (BGCT) (1 vacancy)

Reference: MOSES/ BGCT/2018-017

A competition is open for the attribution of 1 **Science and Technology Management Grant** in the framework of the project with reference **EAPA_224/2016 MOSES - Maritime, Ocean Sector and Ecosystem Sustainability: fostering blue growth in Atlantic industries -**, within the R&D Institution **CIIMAR (Interdisciplinary Centre of Marine and Environmental Research)**, supported by the **Interreg Atlantic Area programme**, according to the following conditions:

1. Scientific area: Biological Sciences/Science Communication

2. Admission requirements

The candidate must hold a BSc in the field of Biological Sciences/Ecology preferably with advanced training in Science communication.

The candidate must have technical and scientific training in the participation and management of international scientific research projects related to ocean sustainability.

The candidate will have a very good work autonomy.

Very good fluency in English is expected as well as Spanish and/or French proficiency.

3. Work plan:

The candidate will mainly concentrate on developing the cooperation and communication between different European Universities and other research Institutions involved in maritime sustainable economy. The work will principally focus on the potential capitalization of the project results especially the policy integration among partners.

4. Legislation and official rules:

Law nº. 40/2004, 18th August (Research Fellowship and Studentship Regulation); Regulations for Studentships and Fellowships of the Fundação para a Ciência e a Tecnologia, I.P. and CIIMAR Grants Regulation.

5. Work place:

The work will be carried out at CIIMAR, under the scientific supervision of Prof. João Coimbra.

6. Duration of the grant:

Duration of twelve (12) months, starting in June 2018, under the regime of exclusive dedication, eventually renewable according to legal terms.

7. Monthly maintenance stipend:

The monthly maintenance allowance is €1245 (one thousand two hundred and forty-five euros – Taxe Free), in agreement with the monthly maintenance stipend table of the grants directly attributed by FCT, I.P. within the country (<https://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores>).

8. Selection methods:

The ranking of candidates will be performed by a global evaluation based on adequacy of the degrees (30%); evaluation of the Curriculum Vitae (50%), experience in the field (20%). The jury reserves the right to interview the first three candidates; the interview will be scored at 50%.

10. Form of Advertising/notification of results:

The final results of the evaluation will be published through a list sorting the candidates according to their attributed mark, on the CIIMAR website and by e-mail; in case of disagreement, the candidates have a 10-working day term in which to contest the decision, if he/she so wishes, as provided for in

the Código do Procedimento Administrativo in a preliminary hearing setting. The jury reserves the right to not assign the grant depending on the quality of the applications.

11. Deadline for application and presentation of applications:

The competition is open from **29th May until 12th June 2018**. The applications must be formalized, compulsorily, by sending the following documents:

- detailed Curriculum vitae
- copy of the eligibility certificates
- motivation letter
