The Portuguese node of the European Marine Biological Resource Centre (EMBRC.PT) is a distributed research infrastructure with installations in Faro, Horta, Coimbra and Porto. It will allow researchers to study marine biodiversity in its habitat, in tanks and in the laboratory with the latest technologies. EMBRC.PT provides services in marine sciences: access to marine ecosystems and biodiversity, microorganism collections and model organisms, research boats, scientific diving, omics, bioinformatics and chemistry platforms. It will also offer access to a variety of aquaria facilities, general laboratories, outdoor experimental facilities, shallow water hydrothermal vents and marine observatories for long term observations. The present project was designed to significantly improve the EMBRC.PT infrastructure and human resources so as to meet the excellence requirements of the European infrastructure and to promote research, training and knowledge transfer, so as to impact positively in the regional and national economy.
