

RESEARCH GRANT (BM) (1 vacancy)

REF. ValorMar/BI-MSc/2017-070

On the 23rd February 2018, the jury constituted by Patrícia Cardoso (president of the jury), Rodrigo Ozório and Filipe Castro evaluated the curricula and merits of the candidates to the research grant with the reference ValorMar/BI-MSc/1017-070. This grant will be signed in the framework of the project ValorMar - *Valorização Integral dos Recursos Marinhos: Potencial, Inovação Tecnológica e Novas Aplicações*, with the reference 24517 (10/SI/2016 – I&DT Empresarial – Programas Mobilizadores) within the R&D Institution CIIMAR (Interdisciplinary Centre of Marine and Environmental Research), supported by the European Regional Development Fund (ERDF) and by the European Social Fund (ESF).

For this vacancy were received 13 applications: 1 – Ahsan Hameed, 2 – Ana Jesus, 3 – Cátia Castro, 4 – David Dinis, 5 – Emílio Salas, 6 – Filipa Fontinha, 7 – João André Rocha, 8 – Mariana Sampaio, 9 – Miguel Cabano, 10 – Odete Gonçalves, 11 – Óscar Merini, 12 – Ricardo Pereira, 13 – Ricardo Pires.

According to the admission requirements, one candidate was excluded: Ricardo Pires did not accomplish one of the requirements included in the initial call (master certification with minimum classification of 14/20).

The seriation of the candidates was done according to the following evaluation criteria:

- 1 – Evaluation of the CV (60%)
 - 2 points – insufficient
 - 4 points – poor
 - 6 points – reasonable
 - 8 points – good
 - 10 points – very good

2 - Experience in the research field (40%)

- 2 points – insufficient
- 4 points – poor
- 6 points – reasonable
- 8 points – good
- 10 points – very good

The seriation of the candidates was performed according to the evaluation criteria detailed in the position announcement. Hence, the valid candidates were ranked as following:
