INVESTIGATOR CONTRACT (1 vacancy)

Reference: GLOBALED/IA/2018-026

A competition is open for the attribution of one position for an Investigator in the framework of the project "Globaled - Impacts of global change on environmentally realistic mixtures of endocrine disruptor compounds on the structure and functioning of coastal ecosystems. Implications for a sustainable environment" - No. 030552, within the R&D Institution CIIMAR (Interdisciplinary Centre of Marine and Environmental Research), co-financed by COMPETE 2020, Portugal 2020 and the European Union through the ERDF, and by FCT through national funds, according to the following conditions:

1. Scientific area: Chemistry, Biochemistry or similar areas.

2. Admission requirements

• Candidates must hold a PhD in the field of Chemistry, Biochemistry or related fields.

• Candidates should have experience in the development of analytical techniques, namely HPLC. Also, experience in cleaning and pre-concentration of samples. Candidates with knowledge in Organic Chemistry and experience with Mass Spectrometry will be preferred.

• A demonstrated capacity to perform data analysis, prepare reports and write manuscripts is desirable. Fluency in English is expected.

3. Work plan:

The candidate will work on the Tasks 1 and 3 of the Globaled project. The work plan will focus on the samples processing (cleaning and pre-concentration), validation methods and quantification of progestins in different matrices regarding field work and experimental work.

4. Legislation and official rules:

Decree-Law no. 57/2016 of 29th August, which approved the doctorate hiring regime destined to stimulate scientific and technological employment for all knowledge areas (RJEC), updated by the Law no. 57/2017 of 19th July and Labor Code approved Law







no. 7/2009 of 12th February, under its current reading and Regulatory Decree No. 11-A / 2017, of 29th December.

5. Work place:

The work will be carried out at the Chemistry Department of the University of Aveiro, under the scientific supervision of Dr. Valdemar Esteves.

6. Duration of the contract:

Work contract with non-fixed term, pursuant to the Labor Code.

7. Monthly salary:

The monthly remuneration to be attributed corresponds to level 33 of the single remuneration table, approved by Administrative Rule no. 1553-C / 2008, December 31: 2.128,34 Euros.

8. Selection methods:

The ranking of candidates will be performed by a global evaluation based on:

- Evaluation of the Curriculum Vitae 60%;
- Experience in the research field 40%;
- An interview will be conducted in the case of a tie (only the short-listed candidates will be interviewed). If so, the final classification will result from the previews results: 90% and interview 10%.

The selection is based on candidate scientific and curricular career evaluation, focuses on relevance, quality and up-to-dateness, associated to the contest theme:

a) of scientific and technological production in the last five years, deemed most relevant by the candidate;

b) of research activities, applied or based on practical work, developed in the last five years, deemed most impactful by the candidate;

c) of knowledge extension and dissemination activities developed in the last five years, namely under the scope of the promotion of culture and scientific practices, deemed most relevant by the candidate.

d) of science, technology and innovation management activities, or of experience in monitoring the scientific and technological system or the higher education system, in Portugal or abroad.

The final results of the evaluation will be published through a list sorting the candidates according to their attributed mark, on the CIIMAR website and by e-mail; in case of disagreement, the candidates have a 10-working day term in which to contest the decision, if he/she so wishes, as provided for in the Código do Procedimento Administrativo in a preliminary hearing setting. The jury reserves the right to not assign the grant depending on the quality of the applications.
