SpilLess, a project funded by EMMF, brings an innovative approach to oil spills cleaning, combining bioremediation tools based on native microorganism cooperation and autonomous vehicles.

The workshop will give an overview of the project's concept, present the advantages of using native microorganisms and autonomous vehicles to respond to pollution events and explain how the new approach can be used in a real oil spill scenario. Special attention will be given to the feedback from stakeholders about the future implementation of the SpilLess approach in real case scenarios, such as oil spill incidents inside ports, around industrial and extraction facilities or during transport activities.
